

Homework Policy

Homework practice is for the child's need to review the day's lessons:

- The idea of homework practice is to reinforce the skills learned during that unit.
- To further develop the mastery of the skills.
- To enhance student confidence in their ability to perform the task independently.
- To develop and learn life-long study skills.

For the Students:

- It is the responsibility to bring home their work
- Complete the work
- Have their parent sign it (when requested by the teacher) and return to school.

For the Parent:

- It is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child completes their homework.
- All home work assignments are to be handed in when they are due.

Homework will be assigned 2 - 4 days a week depending on the grade. The following times are based on guidelines appropriate for the listed grade levels:

- Kindergarten: 10 minutes per night
- Grade 1-3: 20 - 30 minutes per night
- Grade 4-6: 30 - 45 minutes per night
